CREDIT TIME SERVED APPLICATION

I understand that to be eligible for time-served credit on a Class C Warrant from the Canyon Municipal Court, the case(s) that I am requesting credit on have been in warrant or are currently in warrant and one of the following requirements are met:

1. The warrant(s) was a charge for which I was arrested; or, I have confirmed with a warrant officer or court clerk that the warrant was issued while I was in custody in a State / Federal prison facility and that I was incarcerated for more than 48 hours or 2 full days; OR
2. I was arrested on the warrant(s) by another agency and held for transfer to \_\_\_\_\_ jail; and
  - \_\_a. I was not transferred because I bonded out on the warrant(s) after 48 hours or 2 days; or,
  - \_\_b. I was released because the Canyon Police Department did not come pick me up, but I was in jail for at least 48 hours or 2 days prior to being released.

If neither of the two above-requirements apply, you DO NOT qualify for full time-served credit and your application will not be accepted for review. You must contact the Canyon Municipal Court to request a court-date. If a warrant exists, you will be required to post a bond to clear the warrants to set the cases for Court. You may also request a payment plan, an indigency review to see if you qualify for a non-monetary option to satisfy the balances owed or you may come see a judge to discuss options to resolve your citation/warrant. If released due to non-pickup by the Canyon Police Department, you may qualify for partial credit time served, and you will need to see a judge to obtain the partial credit and discuss options for satisfying any balance(s) owed.

By signing below, I am entering a plea of NO CONTEST on the charge(s) listed above and waiving my right to a jury trial. I understand that if I am granted time-served credit, the case(s) will be reported as convictions to the DPS and may affect my driver's license and/or criminal history. I attest that my application meets the one of the above requirements and that I am attaching the required proof of incarceration which includes the date of arrest and date of release from custody. I understand that a judge will review the application and provide me with a written order granting or denying time-served credit. I understand that I remain responsible for any balance owed, and I will begin a payment plan or pay the balance in full as ordered.

I acknowledge that if credit for time served is granted, my case(s) will be closed as a conviction(s) and reported to the DPS to be included on my criminal history and/or driving record.
